INTRODUCTION

The Borneo International Beads Award (BIBA) has been established to encourage creativity and original design in the field of bead-making, bead-working and creative bead-stringing. It is organized by Crafthub Sdn. Bhd. and supported by the World Crafts Council (WCC) and World Crafts Council Asia Pacific Region (WCC-APR).

The purpose of the BIBA is to uplift the status of bead-working and bead-making artisans and artists.

CATEGORIES

The Borneo International Beads Award competition is run in three main categories:

- 1) Bead-work ('seed beads', rocaille) - personal adornment
- 2) Bead stringing - necklace, bracelet etc - personal adornment
- 3) Bead-making - glass, ceramic or other material; submit minimum three identical specimens of the entry

PRIZES

1st Prize – Award Trophy, Certificate & USD1000, one award for each category

2nd Prize – Award Trophy, Certificate & USD500, one award for each category

3rd Prize – Award Trophy, Certificate & USD300, one award for each category

Honourable Mentions – Certificate of Merit in each category



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Participant must be at least 18 years of age. There is no restriction as to residence or nationality.
2. Each Participant may enter all 3 categories but is limited to only 1 artifact per category.
3. The artifact must be the work of one person or a collaboration of several persons who undertake(s) that the artifact is his/her/their own origination, and that he or she or they hold all moral and intellectual property rights in that artifact.

4. The artifact must not be entered in any other competition or have previously won any competition.
5. The artifact must be deliverable by post to the Organizer.
6. All entry form and suitably packaged artifact(s) has to reach the Organizer at the latest by 5 p.m. on 1 September 2011. It must be accompanied by the Participant's brief biodata, and a short case history (inspiration, special meaning, materials, procedure) of the planning and fabrication of the artifact.
7. Please declare entries as 'Sample'. The Participant is responsible for safe packaging, postage, insurance etc. The Organizer cannot accept responsibility for damage of artifact(s) during transport.
8. Winners retain all rights to the design, but the Organizer retains the actual entry.
9. By submitting an entry, you give Crafthub Sdn. Bhd. permission to photograph your work for further promotion either in print or in on-line publications, with full credit to the Participant(s).
10. The Competition will be judged by an independent panel of experts in the field. The decision of the judges is final.
11. Should there be only 1 entry for any 1 category, no prize will be awarded unless, in the opinion of the judges such entry would have obtained a prize had there been competition. The Organizer reserves the right to cancel or reduce the number and/or amount of prizes, if in their opinion, there are insufficient entries in a category.
12. BIBA results will be publicized in the local media, and on craft-related websites.
13. The results of the competition will be announced at the Borneo International Beads Conference (BIBCo), 8 October 2011. Prizes will be forwarded to the winners immediately after the event.
14. Non-winning entries will be returned if the Participant bears the cost of packaging and transport.

Note: Due to Customs regulations, gold or precious stones may not be incorporated in the artifact(s) sent from outside Malaysia.
